




Anticipated Course Offerings for 2017 - 2018









Great Oak Academy provides a nurturing environment where students explore God's creation through hands-on science activities and experiments. Final course offerings depend on adequate enrollment in each class. Go to www.Apologia.com to read the 1st chapter (sample module) of any Apologia text.

Monthly Classes Students attend one day a month (September through April) to do lots of FUN science experiments together. We provide you with a reading schedule and engaging activities students may do at home to further explore the concepts investigated during class.

-  **Science A, B, Cs** (6 to 8 year olds)
Teacher-developed, FUN activities and experiments beginning with every letter of the alphabet!
This class runs on a three-year cycle, with new experiments every year. A student could enjoy this three years in a row!
One Thursday each month, 9 AM – Noon (Specific textbook is not required.)
-  **Earth Sciences** This course covers: Astronomy, Geology, and Weather. (8 to 12 year olds)
Apologia text: Exploring Creation with Astronomy by Jeannie Fulbright
Master books: The Geology Book by Dr. John D. Morris; The Weather Book by Michael Oard
One Friday each month, 9 AM - 2 PM
-  **Anatomy** This class introduces students to the parts of the human body and how they work. (8 to 13 year olds)
Apologia text: Exploring Creation with Human Anatomy and Physiology (and Notebooking Journal)
One Thursday each month, 9 AM - 2 PM

Weekly Classes Each class meets two hours per week (August through May). We perform textbook activities as well as many additional experiments and relevant projects. Compound and dissecting microscopes, preserved specimens, chemicals, etc. are provided. Students learn to use these correctly in a science lab environment and enjoy live animals, too!

-  **Chemistry and Physics** Mondays, Noon – 2 PM
For 6th – 8th graders not quite ready for the rigor of General Science or Physical Science
Apologia text: Exploring Creation with Chemistry and Physics and associated Notebooking Journal
-  **General Science** (Generally for 7th or 8th graders) Mondays, 2:30 – 4:30 PM
Apologia text, solutions manual, and a **separate** test booklet for: Exploring Creation with General Science, 2nd Edition and Human Anatomy Coloring Book by Margaret Matt
-  **Physical Science** (Generally for 8th or 9th graders) Tuesdays, Noon – 2 PM
Students may earn high school credit for this course with a final average of at least 85%.
Apologia text, solutions manual, and a **separate** test booklet for: Exploring Creation with Physical Science, 2nd Edition
-  **Biology** (Generally taken the same year as Algebra 1) Tuesdays, 9 – 11 AM (Possible 2nd section Wednesdays, 12:30 – 2:30)
Apologia text, solutions manual, and a **separate** test booklet for: Exploring Creation with Biology, 2nd Edition
-  **Chemistry** (Prerequisite: Completion of Algebra 1) Mondays, 9 – 11 AM
Apologia text and solutions manual for: Exploring Creation with Chemistry, 2nd Edition (**not 3rd Edition**)
(Great Oak Academy has several textbooks and solutions manuals for students to borrow. A separate test booklet is **not** needed.)
-  **Advanced Biology (Human Anatomy and Physiology)** Thursdays, 2:30 – 4:30 PM
This is an advanced, high school level course, exploring the systems of human body and their functions in depth.
(Prerequisite: Completion of Biology. Completion of Chemistry is helpful, but is not a required prerequisite.)
Apologia text and solutions manual for: Exploring Creation with Advanced Biology, 2nd Edition and the Kaplan Anatomy Coloring Book, 5th Edition (A separate test booklet is **not** needed.)
