

Shared Classroom Supplies from each student, kept in class, to be shared (or submit a check for \$15 per student)

- Paper towels, three rolls per student
- 8 Letter-size manila file folders, 3-tab positions
- 1 box gallon-size zip lock bags, freezer quality
- 1 plastic soda bottle (2-liter size, any color, clean & dry, label removed)



When shared classroom supplies are brought in, check off the items turned in on the clipboard.



ALL monthly students need the following supplies with them in their book bag:

- Notebook: 1½ -inch, 3-ring binder (D ring preferable)
- Mechanical pencils, 2 black Sharpie markers
- Good quality scissors the student is comfortable using (If the student is left-handed, please bring left-handed scissors.)
- Colored pencils (PRISMACOLOR is an excellent brand.), pencil sharpener that collects pencil shavings
- Scotch tape, 3 glue sticks, pencil box
- Box of brass (fastener) brads →
- Water bottle (water only, please)
- Snack (for students in class until noon) or lunch (for students in class until 2 pm)
- Backpack or fabric bag for all materials



Write student's full name on ALL personal materials: books, pencil boxes, lunch bags, water bottles, etc.

Additional Supplies for Specific Courses:

Science ABCs

- T-shirt on a hanger: any color, no pocket, long or short-sleeved, full name written on the inside AND on the hanger (Keep T-shirt with hanger **at home** until you receive an email reminder to bring it to class.)

Earth Sciences Clearly write the student's name on supplies below.

- Exploring Creation with Astronomy Either 1st or 2nd edition is fine. (Textbook only; no notebooking journal needed)

Keep the following items **at home** until you receive an email reminder they are needed:

- The Geology Book by Dr. John D. Morris (Needed in December)
- The Weather Book by Michael Oard Either original or new book is fine. (Needed in March)
- T-shirt on a hanger: **BLACK**, no pocket, long or short-sleeved, name written on the hanger and on the inside of the shirt
- BLACK umbrella (for November class) Write student's name on the handle.
- Flashlight (with regular bulb, NOT LED) with fresh batteries (for November class)
- Oatmeal box with plastic lid, cylinder type, **LARGE**: 42 oz. size, empty (for November class)
- 1 styrofoam egg carton, size for 1 dozen eggs (for January class)
- Binoculars (optional, to be used at night to observe the edge of the half-moon or crescent-moon)

Zoology 1: Flying Creatures Write student's full name on all supplies below.

- Zoology 1 Notebooking Journal ← Strongly recommended, but not required (spiral-bound, regular version, **not** junior version)

Keep the following items **at home** until you receive an email reminder they are needed:

- Peterson Field Guide Color-In Book: Birds by Peter Alden and John Sill (optional, but helpful)
- Peterson Field Guide Color-In Book: Butterflies by Robert Michael Pyle and Sarah Anne Hughes (optional, but helpful)
- T-shirt on a hanger: black or dark blue, no pocket, long or short-sleeved, full name written on the inside AND on the hanger
- Empty, plastic bottle with a wide mouth opening; suet basket
- Two identical bird feeders (homemade or store bought)
- Two identical plastic saucers (See text, pp. 55 - 56.)
