- **DISCOVERY SCIENCE CAMP (rising 1st - 4th graders) June 10 - 14 (1 - 4 pm)**

New 2024 activities! Grow crystals, compete in beetle races, split geodes, create a density column, make a motor, play science games indoors and outdoors, assemble electric circuits, make a Cartesian diver, grow your own food in just a few days, make huge bubbles you can climb into, build bridges, make a Hero engine, and lots more!

- **EXPLORER SCIENCE CAMP (rising 5th - 8th graders) June 17 - 21 (1 - 4 pm)**

New 2024 activities! Design and build a CD car to compete in a contest, flip a flame, use lasers in liquids and lenses, learn science magic tricks, fly balloon helicopters, perform oceanography experiments, split light with a prism you make out of water, play science games indoors and outdoors, make an animal biome pop-up book, and lots more!

- **CODING BOOTCAMP (ages 10 and up) June 24 - 28 (1 - 4 pm)**

This camp introduces participants to Python programming - one of the most in-demand programming languages in the world! Campers will learn fundamental programming skills such as using data types, conditional statements, looping, and algorithmic design. The camp will consist of programming exercises centered around creating simple interactive number / word games.
